Thank you for your recent letter and reprints on <u>M. durrovensis</u>. We are attempting to rear freshwater mussels in captivity, with the eventual goal of propagating federally endangered species. Thus far, we have had a problem with high mortality of juveniles between 30-60 days post-metamorphosis. Have you experienced a similar high mortality during some critical period of development? Although most of our research has not been published, I enclose a few items that may be of interest. Please keep me informed on the progress of your culture work. Any tips on successful culture are most welcome.
